

Contest „Save Our Planet!” Regulations

1. Target of the Contest

- Creation of educational and informative issue about environment
- Involvement of young people into updating of environment – related problems
- Promotion of youth’s creative development
- Creation in the society dutiful attitude towards environment

2. Contest Moderator

- *Project Footprints*

3. Time

- The Contest will be carried on in the course of the year with various terms for submission of works, depending upon a date of issue of the newspaper
- The first term – 22nd January 2007
- Further terms will be advised asunder

4. Contest Participants

- Students of universities, higher schools and colleges
- 1-12 class students
- Trainees of professional educational establishments

5. Regulations

- The Contest will be carried on simultaneously in two categories – as a journalistic contest and as a literature contest
- Literary works can be submitted in any form and genre {a poem, a story, a fairy tale, a play and an essay etc }
- There are no thematic restrictions for literary works, but any connection with environmental thematic will be favored
- journalistic works shall be created as a report, study or interview
- journalistic works should be made about author’s topical local environment matters
- execution of works {photos, drawings} shall be considered as advantage for both categories
- neither work submitted for the contest {in both categories} should be published before without coordination with the Contest moderators
- hors concours there might be submitted research works on environmental topics, which shall be published out of turn
- the sent works may subject to editing in accordance with grammatical norms of the Latvian language and curtailed
- the works may be sent under a pen-name or anonymous, but author’s contact information must be indicated

6. Work Submission

- works for contest should be submitted by the end of the defined term, sending thereof to pedas@pedas.lv, or also by post: „*Project Footprints*”, 49 Elizabetes Street, Riga, LV-

7. Work Assessment

- the sent works shall be assessed by a jury founded by the *Project Footprints*

8. Awarding

- the best works shall be published in the *Project’s Footprints* newspaper and in its Internet version
- authors of published works shall receive incentive awards
